Agra – Polio Routine Immunization, Happy School Project – 2 Locations, Taj Mahal, Agra Fort, and Mehtab Bagh, Fatehpur Sikri – Bharatpur , Ranthambore – 2 Jungle Safari, Jaipur – Amber Fort, City Palace , Hawa Mahal – Neemrana Fort and Palace - Delhi and much more



Day 1: Delhi arrival | 22nd October 2026 | Thursday

Arrival at New Delhi International Airport (IGI)

Arrival by International flight, Welcome to Incredible India, meeting and assistance on arrival, Indian magic begins here with Traditional Garland and Welcome Drink on arrival (A chilled glass of Indian Kingfisher Beer/ Soft Drinks), transfer to hotel, time to relax and acclimate to the new time zone. Overnight in Delhi.

Day 2: Delhi – Agra | The City of Taj Mahal_| **Polio Awareness Rally | 23rd October 2026, Friday**

Breakfast and check out by 8am, transfer to Agra by private air-conditioned transport via Yamuna Express Way (3.5 hours Comfortable drive). On arrival Lunch at Award Winning Local Indian Restaurant, check-in and relax. Further transfer for taking part in Polio Rally/Road Show, wearing Polio Message Aprons and Caps (covering few Villages, apprx 2 Hours). This is very exciting and meaningful. At Rally you will get chance to feel common Indian lifestyle, cross by their homes in slums, express your feelings and ideas before the public about polio eradication "Keep India Polio Free "mission with advertisement banner of your club/district. You will go into the streets for distribution of fliers which mention the prevention and safety from polio, this all as a procession, dancing, beating drums with ending up with a masala India Tea, back to hotel and relax. Day 3: Agra - Polio Immunization | 24th October 2026, Saturday **“WORLD POLIO DAY “**

After breakfast, transfer to Polio Booths and D/Type Help Post with advertisement banner of Polio along with members of UNICEF, WHO and Local Medical Representative and Rotarians with visit to nearby Malinbasti (slum areas) in rural deep pockets. Further distribute flyers with polio eradication message and later personally give Polio drops. There you will accompany with volunteers' doctor and Rotarians who helps you to give two

drops of Polio Vaccine to children's up to the age of 5 years. Later I have the opportunity to go door to door to give polio drops in slums till noon, back to Agra and enjoy Cooking Session with lunch at local family, back to hotel and relax.

Evening Walking Tour of Old City (bazaars, spice market, temple, mosque and much more) and Dinner and Drinks - Hosted by Rotarian Rahul Wadhwa Family at his house. Overnight at Agra. Meals B,L,D

Day 4: Agra | 25th October 2026, Sunday

Rise early for the incredible highlight of your tour – the once-in-a-lifetime experience of watching the sunrise at the spectacular Taj Mahal, one of the finest pieces of architecture in the world. This exquisite monument to eternal love was created by Shah Jahan in response to his adored wife's dying wish that he should 'build a tomb in her memory such as the world had never seen before'. Be mesmerized by the captivating beauty of the Taj as it appears to change color as the light changes and takes on an ethereal pink glow. Back to hotel for Breakfast and relax. Further visit Cottage Industries Exposition for World best known Kashmiri Handmade rugs/carpets which is well known since Mughal Era, visit Agra fort, an era marked by invasions and fortifications, where power was symbolized by grand palaces and grander forts during such time was built The Agra Fort, Textiles Emporium (Mughal /Western Style) final chance to order outfits (for Ladies/Gents) in silk & other materials, which would be stitched/ designed as per your gentle size in just few hours. In the evening at 6:30pm you will enjoy the real love story of Taj Mahal in a magnificent drama show which is dedicated to Shah Jahan and his wife Mumtaz Mahal - A lifetime experience Dinner (Own). Day 5: Agra – Rotary Projects | 26th October 2026, Monday



After breakfast, visit Inlay marble factory, live show of worksmanship by the workers inlaying the one stone in another from the time of Mughals, further visit the Vishwa Bharti Public School as "Happy School" (Pilot Project) under Rotary Foundation Global Grant Project # 1991094.

Lunch hosted, proceed to visit AP Inter College for "Girls Toilet Block" under Rotary Foundation Global Grant Project # 1639615, back to hotel and relax.

Sunset Dinner at Oberoi Amarvilas overlooking Taj Mahal (own). Meals: B, L.

Day 6: Agra – Other Projects | 27th October 2026, Tuesday

After breakfast, Visit to Rotary Eye Hospital and Glass Factory visit – Firozabad. Evening on leisure, open for personal activities. Overnight at Agra. Meals B.

Day 7: Agra to Fatehpur Sikri | Transfer to Indian Railways via Fatehpur Sikri to Board train Tiger Reserve, Ranthambore National Park | 28th October 2026, Wednesday



Rise up early after breakfast, transfer to Fatehpur Sikri magnificent palace built by Akbar on mountains of Sikri and named it "Fatehpur Sikri", India's royal ghost town. Lunch at Heritage Hotel Laxmi Vilas Palace a lifetime experience to visit this castle which highlights lifestyle of maharaja and family staying and you enjoy.

Lunch like a maharaja in this palace. Later board Super-Fast Train (KOTA JANSHTBDI 12060 @03:50 – 06:03 PM) to Ranthambore. On arrival, check in Ranthambore. Meals B, L, D.

This former hunting ground of Jaipur's maharajas has been under the protection of Project Tiger since the early 1970s and it attracts nature-lovers from around the world eager to spot the endangered and mighty Bengal tigers. A wealth of wildlife inhabits the park including the leopard, hyena, jackal, sloth bear, crocodile and spotted deer as well as countless birds. Experience the thrill of a jeep safari as you embark on a game journey from the Aravalis Mountains to the Vindhya Range in search of the elusive tiger. Visit historic Ranthambore Fort which is over 1,000 years old and offers breathtaking views of the park from its hill-top setting. Bird lovers flock to Ranthambore to watch the many colorful species that inhabit the park. You may be lucky enough to spot the woodpecker, bee, eater, kingfisher, parakeet, pelican and flamingo.

Day 8: Ranthambore | INTO THE JUNGLE | 29th October 2026, Thursday

Early morning, enjoy Shared Jeep Safari (1st Trip, Included) accompanied by naturalist who takes you on an exciting and adventures journey inside jungles of Ranthambhore. Return for breakfast. Re visit game park in afternoon Shared Jeep safari (2nd Trip Included) again accompanied by naturalist in Jungles of Ranthambhore as one of the few preserves were nocturnal, camera-shy tigers may be seen in (sunset) during feeding. Evening on leisure with local cultural activities at resort. Overnight in Ranthambore. Meals B, L, D.



Special experience: Early morning and afternoon Open Jeep Safari with Private Naturalist

DAY 9: Ranthambore to Jaipur (approx. 4 hrs by road) | 30th October 2026, Friday



Early morning Shared Jeep safari (3rd Trip, included), back to resort for breakfast, relax and checkout and travel overland to Jaipur, enjoy your lunch on the way. Once you arrive in Jaipur, you'll get transferred to your hotel. Later visit the imposing City Palace, a unique and arresting complex of several palaces, pavilions, gardens, and temples a massive, still home to the Maharaja although several of the rooms are now open to the public. Many antiques and artifacts belonging to the ruling family are housed here, including a collection of weaponry, enjoy a

leisurely walk around. Overnight in Jaipur. Meals B.

Special experience: Elephant Ride | visit City Palace

Day 10: Jaipur | THE PINK CITY | 31st October 2026, Saturday

Explore the 'Pink City' of Jaipur with a full day of sightseeing. Drive Pass through Hawa Mahal (Wind Palace), admire from where the palace queen could watch the activities of big bazaar without being seen. Later excursion to impressive Amber Fort which overlooks Maota Lake. At the foot of the hill, you will mount your caparisoned elephant for the slow but steady climb up to the main gate, making your entrance in the time-honored fashion. Shopping at Gem Palace – Jewellery, handicrafts, clothes and the famous lakh bangles as Jaipur is one of the most active jewel markets of the world, famous for its precious and semi-precious stones. Lunch @ local Ethnic restaurant, enjoy your walking tour of Bapu Bazar where you will explore the local shops. Overnight in Jaipur. Meals B, L.

Optional: Complimentary Transport Service only for Dinner – Suggested places Shikaar Bagh, Sky Fall, House of people, Copper Chimney.

Day 11: Jaipur – Neemrana (approx. 2.45 hrs by road) | 01st November 2026, Sunday



After Breakfast, check out and transfer overland to Neemrana, situated on Jaipur- Delhi highway. Neemrana Fort & Palace (553 years old medieval Fort-Palace) Built on the 2-billion-year-old Aravalli hills, witness the most spectacular sunsets over the countryside. In afternoon enjoy the Camel ride. Zip line , Free time - Let yourself be guided around the fort and time at pool. Overnight in Neemrana Fort Palace with music and folk dances . Meal B.

Special experience: Camel Ride at Neemrana Village

Day 12: Neemrana – Delhi | 2nd November 2026, Monday

After Breakfast, check out and transfer overland to Delhi, upon arrival check in and relax. Visit The Lotus Temple, located in Delhi, India, is a Bahá'í House of Worship that was dedicated in December 1986. Notable for its flowerlike shape, it has become a prominent attraction in the city. Like all other Bahá'í Houses of Worship, the Lotus Temple is open to all, regardless of religion or any other qualification., continuing your city tour to Raj Ghat, back to hotel . Meals B.



Day 13: Delhi | 03rd November 2026, Tuesday



Today our exploration of India begins with full day sightseeing of Old Delhi and New Delhi, exploring its most treasured sites. You'll enjoy guided tours to major tourist attractions, drive through Red Fort, visit Jama Masjid, enjoy rickshaw ride on hustling and bustling streets of Chandni Chowk. Lunch at Ethnic restaurant (Ancient Indian styled cuisines), you will also see the high stone arch of India Gate; the ceremonial boulevard of pond-flanked Rajpath; and the official residence of the President of India, the copper-domed Rashtrapati Bhawan and Parliament


